NEW Works Garage in Apsley for North Kawartha

NEW fire hall, training facility, and heliport in Apsley
Reconstructing and Hard topping of Anstruther Lake Road
Purchasing and cleaning up the old Watson property on Burleigh St
Purchasing of land near Balmer Road and hwy. 620 for proposed seniors residences

What are your top three (3) priorities for 2010 - 2014
